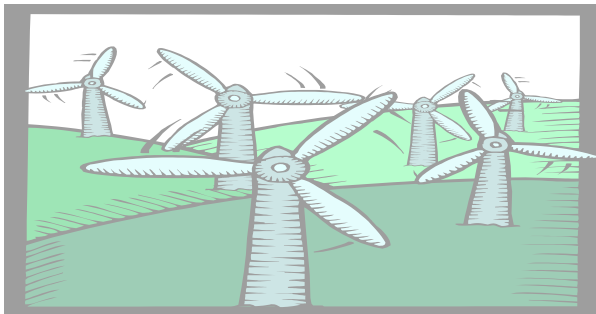
## Agritourism
